INSPIRA ELMER RECEIVES NEW JERSEY’S FIRST PRISM AWARD

Inspira Medical Center Elmer is the first hospital in New Jersey – and one of only 10 hospitals in the nation – to receive the Academy of Medical-Surgical Nurses’ PRISM Award.

This prestigious award recognizes exceptional nursing practice, leadership and outcomes in hospital medical-surgical departments across the United States.

The award, which stands for “Premier Recognition in the Specialty of Med-Surg,” is the first of its kind honoring acute care medical-surgical departments. It was presented to Inspira Elmer’s 2 East Medical-Surgical Unit at an award ceremony on January 4 by co-sponsors the Academy of Medical-Surgical Nurses (AMSIN) and the Medical-Surgical Nursing Certification Board (MSNCB).
